



Vaccines

All teachers will follow the state mandate and have their Covid vaccines or have submitted a religious or medical waiver.

Normally we would be fine with children coming to school with sniffles, sneezes, coughs or stuffy nose, if COVID is still a consideration please use extra precaution and keep them home.

Children with fever, diarrhea or vomiting the previous 24 hours should stay at home. If anyone in your family is showing these signs your child should stay home. They must be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school AND not have shown any other signs of COVID-19. If they have shown other signs of COVID-19 they will need to follow the below procedures.

If a child has any symptoms or starts to show symptoms during class we will immediately call an adult for pick-up.

Masks



Masking while outdoors in both programs is optional. Preschool students are completely outdoors with a lot of space for natural distanced play.

For the elementary they are mask free for 5 hours of the school day.

Teachers



We will monitor students' health. If symptoms pop up, we will call for immediate pickup.

We will encourage frequent hand-washing, keeping fingers away from face, nose, and eyes, covering mouths for coughs and sneezes.

We will provide each family with an updated waiver that will include the unique circumstances of this pandemic.

We have started to have any outside monthly tours.



Parents

Be aware of your child's health. Monitor them for any symptoms including consistent cough, fever, shortness of breath, fatigue. Do not send your child to school if they exhibit any of these symptoms. If they are showing any of these symptoms we will call you and have them picked up without exception.

Do not send your child to school if they have been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19. This includes classmates.

If your child has been boosted OR completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months OR completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months:

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.

If you develop symptoms, get a test and stay home.

If your child completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted OR completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted OR are unvaccinated:

- Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- If you can't quarantine you must wear a mask for 10 days.
- Test on day 5 if possible.

If they develop symptoms, get a test and keep them home.

Any immediate changes will be communicated to enrolled families through email and an updated parent handbook.
